Life Group Discussion Questions

This Sunday, we learned about the important role of prayer in seeing our loved ones come to Christ. Prayer is the greatest tool we have to win the battle for our friends and family. Today we'll put this truth into practice!

MY STORY – Even if you know how important prayer is, it can be a struggle to actually pray. Sometimes it's because we feel like we don't have time, we don't know the right words to say, or we don't know if God is really listening. What keeps you from praying?

Throughout this series, we are being challenged to pray for three friends to come to God. Share briefly who you are praying for and write their names below. We'll be praying specific prayers for them today.

DIGGING DEEPER

Key Verses: 2 Peter 3:9 NCV - "The Lord is not slow in doing what he promised...God is being patient with you. He does not want anyone to be lost, but he wants all people to change their hearts and lives."

1 John 5:14-15 ESV - "...If we ask anything according to his will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of him."

What can we conclude from these verses about what God wants for the people on your list? What part do we play in accomplishing His will?

Join Jesus in His Present Day Ministry

On Sunday, we learned that Jesus is praying for us even now. What specific things do you think He is praying for you? How can His prayers help you bring your friends to Him?

You Release the Power of the Holy Spirit

Throughout Scripture, the Holy Spirit operates in different ways. Here are some highlights that can guide our prayers:

- At Creation, the Holy Spirit hovered over the surface of the earth, preparing the way for God's creative work (Genesis 1:2)
- The Holy Spirit brings conviction of sin, God's righteousness, and judgment (John 16:8)
- The Holy Spirit comforts (John 14:16)
- The Holy Spirit guides and instructs (Nehemiah 9:20)
- The Holy Spirit comes in power (Acts 1:7-8)

Prayer: I pray that the Holy Spirit would do a new thing in the lives of ______; that he would convict them of sin, righteousness, and judgment; that he would comfort, guide, and instruct them; and that he would show up in their lives in a powerful, supernatural way.
