Financial Responsibility

71% contribute 50% or more of household earnings

42% are the primary income earner in their household

What do you find most challenging?

46% indicated issues regarding time

How Successfully do you feel you are balancing your multiple responsibilities?

13% very well 29% good 13% just ok 38% not well at all

Balancing Additional Responsibilities

parent of preschoolers, school age children, and/or teenagers;
single parent; care for aged family member;

part time student; regularly work overtime;
commute five or more hours per week.

Time and Priorities

Results of a national survey of women:*

Priorities - Church & faith based activities ranked the 2nd highest priority (11%)

Time Commitments – Church & faith based activities ranked the lowest (5%)

Desired Improvement – Church & faith based activities ranked highest (22%)

Conclusions:

Women in the workplace are very, very busy. So much so that they often struggle to align their time commitments with their own priorities.

Women want to connect with others in faith based environments, but it is a challenge to find the time and to align their schedules with the church's schedule.
